REMINDERS!!

- Please remember to sharpen your mower blades prior to first cut this season and through out the year.
- Mow higher during the warmer months so lawn looks its best. Cutting short and scalping will yellow out lawn and make it tougher to grow back in dry conditions.
- Remember to switch up the directions that you cut your lawn each week to help the lawn develop a little better.
- If you do any SEEDING in the Spring please let us know so we can work around it and make sure we can help your seed grow in a timely manner.
- If you do not have **GRUB** control scheduled this season please call so we can explain to you the benefits of that application.
- Mark your calendars for seeding in the Fall

Seeding is **BEST** in the **FALL** but if you wish to do any spot seeding in the spring feel free, but it's usually a 50-50 shot. Please call the office to get scheduled or view your account **ONLINE** and you can get a price emailed to you immediately.

Nimblewill

is a wiry, upright growing perennial grass and is considered an invasive weed that invades lawns, flowerbeds, and gardens.

It really stands out in cool season grasses, especially when dormant when the grass is tan colored. In summer, nimblewill is a lighter shade of green than most cool season grasses and has a very different blade texture, so again, it easily stands out. Nimblewill is a warm season, perennial



grass. Winter Dormant Nimblewill in a Fescue Lawn once established, it will green up as soil temperatures warm in mid-spring. It greens up about the same time or shortly after other warm season grasses, but long after cool season grasses begin to grow.

Bittercress

Is a winter annual that is a prolific seeding plant. Early spring weed control use can be difficult because herbicides have a hard time translocating through plants in cooler weather.



Mowing the lawn short early March can reduce seed populations which will reduce plants for the following season.

WINTER DAMAGE

The snowy off-season has finally come and gone but it left some damage behind.

Snow Mold is common with snow laying for more then a few weeks. It leaves blotchy areas that should bounce back when the weather is more consistent and fertilization is applied.

Red Thread or Pink Patch

This is a common fungus that occurs in late spring. The fungus is very mild and usually grows out in 2 to 3 cuts. This fungus/disease only affects the grass blade not the root system.
