



TREE/SHRUB PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- **TREE 1:** Spring Dormant Oil suppresses overwintering insects and egg masses. (March)
- **TREE 2:** Spring Fertilization granular and/or liquid nutrients for various trees & shrubs. (March thru May)
- **TREE 3:** Spring Insect/Disease treatment for plants prone to early pest/fungus issues. **(April thru June)**
- **TREE 4:** Summer Insect/Disease treatment for plants prone to Beetles and other summer pests (June thru July)
- **TREE 5:** Late Summer Insect Control for plants prone to mites, bagworms & webworms. (August thru September)
- **TREE 6:** Fall Fertilization granular and/or liquid nutrients for various plants with stress issues. (Aug. thru Nov.)
- **TREE 7:** Fall Dormant Oil for persistent pest issues and those known to overwinter on landscapes. **(November)**
- **TREE 8:** Winter Protection anti desiccant for broadleaf evergreens and some conifers. **(December)**
- TU1, TU2, TU3: Series of fungicides for plants prone to fungus issues. (April thru June)
- **FB1, FB2, FB3, FB4:** Series of special treatments for fire blight, rust, etc on Pears, 'Apples, Cherrys. (April thru May)
- TB, TBT: Borer Control treatments for various wood boring pests. (March thru May)
- **DR1-6:** Deer Repellent Program for plants prone to deer damage. (Bi-monthly)
- **TSO, TSF:** Soil Drench Systemic applied to root zones for various difficult pests.

(TSO -spring, TSF -fall)

- **TGR:** Soil Drench Growth Regulator for mature trees to help with certain stress factors. (Spring or Fall)
- **TMI:** High Iron & Micronutrient treatment for chlorosis and other special needs. (Spring or Fall)
- SLS: Soil Drench Systemic for large trees and birch, willows, etc. to control SLF. (March-May)
- SLT: Trunk Drench Systemic for smaller trees prone to SLF activity. (May thru October)
- **SLN:** Spotted Lanternfly nymph stage control. (May thru June)
- **SLA:** Spotted Lanternfly adult stage control. (July thru August)
- **SLB:** Spotted Lanternfly adult stage control. (September thru October)
- **SLX:** Additional SLF control for persistent populations on trees of prime concern. (November)
